FITTING INSTRUCTIONS

- Using the T30 torx, remove the OEM bar end bolt, keeping the OEM washer, handguard, spacer & bar end in place (Picture 1).
- Place the M6 bolt (ITEM 3) through the washer (ITEM 2) & bar end bobbin (ITEM 1).
- With (ITEM 1) and (ITEM 2) together, now thread the bolt through the OEM washer, handguard, spacer & bar end and tighten to the correct torque setting as shown above in <u>GENERAL TORQUE SETTINGS</u> (Picture 2).
- Place the M6 nut cap (ITEM 4) in the end of the bolt & repeat for the other side of the motorcycle.
- Ensure the product is tight and secure before riding.
