


FITTING INSTRUCTIONS FOR ECS0120BK ENGINE CASE SLIDERS KTM DUKE 125 '17- (RIGHT HAND SIDE ONLY)

 $\overline{\text{ITEM 1}} = M6 \times 50 \text{mm}$ LONG CAP HEAD BOLTS (x3).


ITEM 2 = M6 WASHERS (3x).

ITEM 3 = ENGINE CASE SLIDER (ECS0120) (x1).

ITEM 4 = COMP SLEEVE (PRE-FITTED) (CS473) (x1).

TOOLS REQUIRED

- Socket set to include 4, 5mm A/F socket & wrench.
 - 8mm spanner or socket & wrench.

FITTING INSTRUCTIONS

Right side (as you sit on bike)

- Remove the four bolts that secure the belly pan in place (as arrowed in picture 1) and remove the belly pan.
- Remove the three M6 bolts as positioned where the slider fits, as shown in picture 2.
- Offer the slider (Item 3) in position.
- Insert the button head bolts (Item 1) with washers (item 2) through the three mounting points as shown in the exploded diagram.
- Tighten evenly to manufactures specified torque.
- Place the bubble sticker in the allocated profile in the slider (as shown in picture 3).
- Re-fit the belly pan as original.



 - Clé à molette 8mm



NOTICE DE MONTAGE:

Côté droit (lorsqu'on est assis sur la moto)

- Enlever les 4 boulons qui fixent le ventre en place (voir photo 1) puis enlevez le ventre de carénage.
- Enlever les 3 boulons M6 à l'endroit où le slider se positionne, voir photo 2.
- Placer le slider (Article3) in position.
- Insérez les boulons (Article 1) avec rondelles (article 2) dans les 3 points de fixation, voir le schéma.
- Serrer selon les valeurs de serrage recommandées.
- Placer le sticker en caoutchouc dans le profil correspondant du slider (voir photo 3).
- Remonter le ventre de carénage comme à l'origine.
