


# Fitting Instructions for SRG0025 Radiator Guard HONDA CB650F and CBR650F 2013





In This Kit There Should Be 1x Radiator Guard (SRG0025). 2x 100mm Lengths of self-adhesive Foam. 2x Black Cable Ties (220mm)

## **TOOLS REQUIRED**

Socket set to include 8 and 10mm socket & wrench.

## FITTING INSTRUCTIONS

- To fit the radiator guard to the bike cut the foam strip provided into 10mm wide pieces and stick them to the back of the radiator guard frame, so that they sit between the radiator guard and the radiator.
- Remove the upper mounting bolt as arrowed in picture 1.
- Remove the lower mounting bolt as arrowed in picture 2.
- Offer the radiator guard into position and reuse the original bolts to secure the upper and lower mounts as shown in picture.
- Use one of the cable ties through the slots to secure the radiator into position as shown in picture 3.
- Tighten all bolts evenly and ensure the radiator is correctly mounted.


#### **R&G RACING RETURNS POLICY (NON-FAULTY GOODS)**

Returns must be pre-authorised (if not pre-authorised the return will be rejected). Goods may only be returned direct to us if they were purchased direct from us (customer must prove if necessary). Otherwise to be returned to original vendor. Goods must be in re-sellable condition, in the opinion of R&G Racing. All returns are subject to a 25% restocking and handling fee (25% of the gross value exc. P&P – at the prevailing price at time of purchase). The customer must pay any and all carriage charges. No returns of discontinued products, unless within 14 days of purchase. This policy does not affect your statutory rights and does not refer to faulty goods.



# INSTRUCTIONS DE MONTAGE POUR SRG0025 Grille de protection HONDA CB650F and CBR650F 2013





## Le kit doit contenir:

1x Grille de protection (RAD0155BK) 2x 100mm Mousse autocollante 2 x serre câble (220mm)

## **OUTILS REQUIS**

Jeu de clés 8 et 10mm.

## Instructions de montage:

- Couper la mousse en bandeaux de 10mm puis collez ces bandeaux au bas du support de protection radiateur, de façon à ce que ces bandeaux se situent entre la protection radiateur et le radiateur.
- Enlever le boulon de fixation supérieur (Photo 1).
- Enlever le boulon de fixation inférieur (Photo 2).
- Mettre la grille en position et réutiliser les boulons d'origine pour fixer les supports supérieurs et inférieurs (Photo).
- Utiliser un des colliers de serrage dans les fentes pour fixer le radiateur en position (Photo 3).
- Serrer tous les boulons de façon égale et veiller à ce que le radiateur soit correctement monté.
