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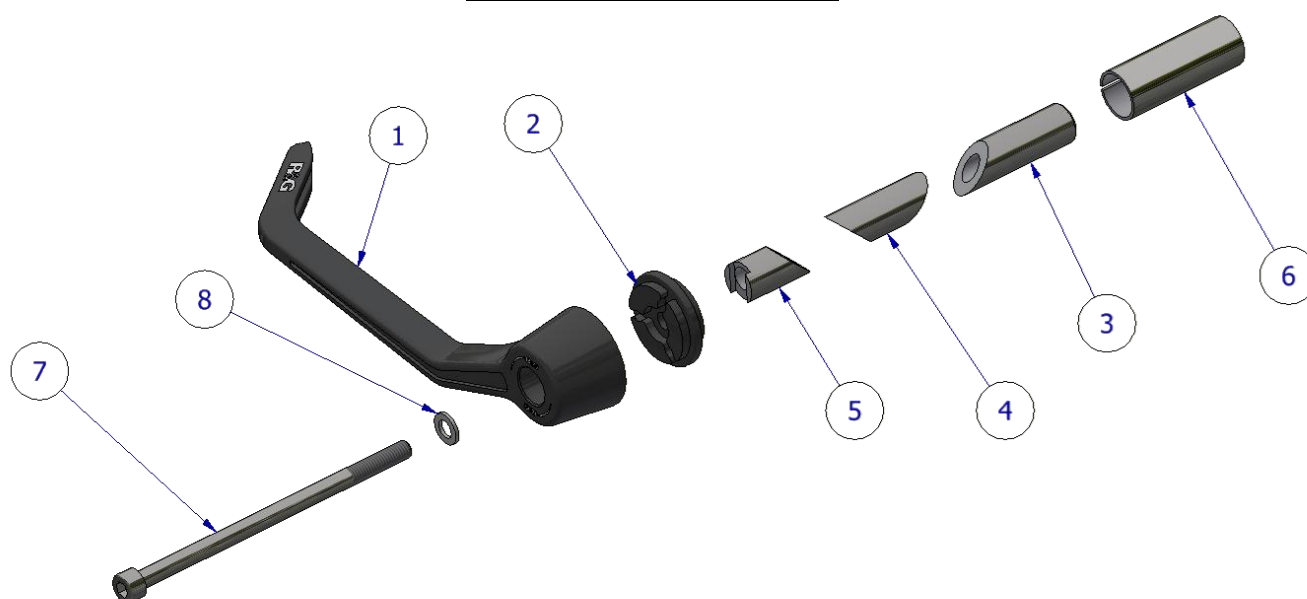

FITTING INSTRUCTIONS

- Pre-assemble Items 1-5 & 7-8 in the orientation shown in the assembly diagram, however, do not tighten the bolt at this stage - items 3-5 should form a concentric cylinder.
- If the internal bar diameter is 17mm or over, place the sleeve (**Item 6**) over items 3-5 of the assembly.
- Place the assembly inside the bar end, ensuring not to inhibit any throttle action and making sure the spacer (**item 2**) is sitting inside the slot of the anti-rotation section of the expander (**item 5**).
- Tighten the bolt until the assembly is secure in the bar. Do not exceed 15Nm of torque.

IMPORTANT - WHEN FITTING THIS PRODUCT, IT IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY TO ENSURE THAT THE PRODUCT IN NO WAY IMPEDES THE OPERATION OF THE MOTORCYCLE AND IS CHECKED REGULARLY FOR TIGHTNESS AND CORRECT OPERATION.

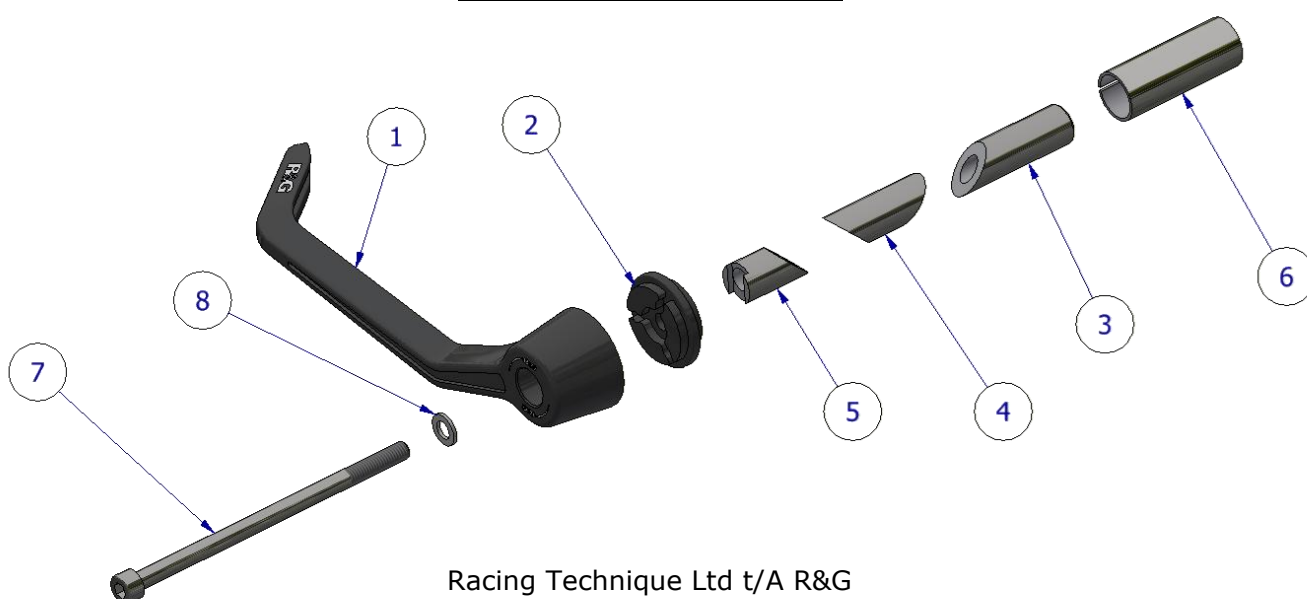

NOTICE DE MONTAGE

- Pré-assemblez les articles 1 à 5 et 7 à 8 dans l'orientation indiquée sur le schéma d'assemblage, mais ne serrez pas le boulon à ce stade - les articles 3 à 5 doivent former un cylindre concentrique.
- Si le diamètre interne de la barre est de 17 mm ou plus, placez le manchon (article 6) sur les articles 3 à 5 de l'assemblage.
- Placez l'assemblage à l'intérieur de l'extrémité de la barre, en veillant à ne pas gêner l'action de l'accélérateur et en vous assurant que l'entretoise (article 2) soit placée à l'intérieur de la fente de la section anti-rotation de l'extenseur (article 5).
- Serrez le boulon jusqu'à ce que l'assemblage soit bien fixé dans la barre. Ne dépassez pas 15 Nm de couple.
