



FITTING INSTRUCTIONS

- Firstly, place the supplied rubber bungs (**Item 5**) on a 3mm allen key, and gently push them through the holes on the oil cooler guard (**Item 1**) as shown in **Picture 1**.
- Then apply the supplied rubber u-channel to the top radius as seen in Picture 1.
- Then remove the 2X original bolts that are circled red in Picture 2.
- Offer the assembly up to the bike with the spacers (**Item 2**), bolts (**Item 3**) and washers (**Item 4**) held in the positions shown in the assembly diagram.
- Make sure the top radius with the rubber u-channel is sitting firmly in the dimpled plastic above the oil cooler. (As shown in **Picture 3**)
- Finally, thread the supplied bolts (**Item 3**) with washers (**Item 4**) into the mounts.
- Torque all bolts to their required settings and check at regular intervals.




